IAH admits students from Toddlers through Sixth Grade. Children are eligible for acceptance into the school from the age of two years and sixth months. Preschool students must be toilet-trained to be admitted to the program.

## UNIFORMS

Uniforms are required for Kindergarten and above. Shirts should be plain white without pictures.

- K-4 Boys Navy blue dress pants or shorts and a white shirt with a collar. Solid navy blue sweaters if needed.
- K-3 Girls Navy blue jumper or skirt, or dress pants and a white shirt with a collar. Solid navy blue sweaters if needed.
- 4-6 Boys Navy blue or black dress pants and a white shirt with a collar. Solid navy blue or black sweaters if needed.
- 4-6 Girls Navy blue or black long skirt, jumper or dress pants; a long sleeved white blouse with a collar, and a plain white scarf one piece or pinned. Solid navy or black sweaters if needed.

K – 6 have Physical Education classes; athletic shoes are required for PE. Platforms and sandals are not appropriate school shoes.
